Melbourne Cup Weekend Fly-away to Hobart

In the absence of David Marty, Steve Hitchen briefed club members on the impending Hobart trip over the Melbourne Cup weekend in October/November. The main points were:

- Plan So far: Dep YLIL mid-morning via Wilsons Prom, Deal Island, Flinders Island
- Perhaps land YFLI for lunch
- Onward to Barnbougle for afternoon and overnight stay
- Sunday am –Dep for short hop to Georgetown to refuel. Then across to St Helens or hit east coast just north at Bay of Fires. Then coastal to Friendly Beaches Airstrip (1000 m gravel) for morning /lunch. Then coastal over Freycinet and into either Cambridge (for those with controlled airspace) or Sandfly just 16 nm south-west for others. Pick up mini buses at Cambridge/Hobart and run down to Sandfly to get the others. Sunday and Monday nights in Hobart.
- Hobart Monday activity possibilities: MONA, Mt Wellington, Antarctic Exhibition, Maritime Museum
- Cadbury Factory tour and cruise up river to get there. Coal river farm, Tas museum and art gallery open to any other suggestions
- Tues Am return home either east coast or if weather good perhaps across to Strahan (fuel?), up the coast or over cradle mountain (spectacular slight diversion) onward to King Island (overfly or land) Cape Otway and home via the heads and up Mornington Peninsula
- Dave will finalise numbers after the General Meeting and will then ask for \$100 /head deposit to proceed.
